



AGREEMENT REGARDING THE SHIPPING OF PERSONAL EFFECTS AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS

Dear Customer:

When you sign the Bill of Lading to ship your personal effects/belongings, you will note that for insurance purposes you state a value of the shipment not to exceed 10 cents per pound.

In order to obtain the lowest charge (rate) on your shipment, World Cargo International Services describes and ships all personal effects as “personal effects, released value not to exceed 10 cents per pound.”

In the event of damage or loss, you will be paid only 10 cents per pound on the claims items. We suggest you contact your personal insurance company and obtain a “Moving in Transit” insurance rider. World Cargo International Services does not provide extra insurance.

All shipments are rated to port only for customer pick-up and rates don't include delivery unless otherwise stated on the bill of lading. Please understand that after notification that your goods have arrived, storage charges may be assessed.

All personal effects shipments must be prepaid to destination by cash, credit card or check.

The agreed or declared value of each article in this shipment is hereby specifically stated by the shipper to be not exceeding 10 cents per pound. I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the above supplement to my bill of lading. I certify that I am the owner of the goods, or that if I am not the owner of the goods that I will protect and indemnify World Cargo International Services from any claim in excess of 10 cents per pound from the owner of the goods.
